Overview

InfoPrint ProcessDirector is an extensible, configurable output process management system that lets you start small and grow over time. With core capabilities plus optional add-on features, InfoPrint ProcessDirector allows flexible control of your print and mail production processes. It can streamline operations, improve process integrity, enhance operator productivity, reduce errors and help lower costs. InfoPrint ProcessDirector is also the backbone software of InfoPrint Automated Document Factory solutions: Mailroom Integrity, Postal Optimization and Output Management.

This release of InfoPrint ProcessDirector focuses on enhancements for handling Adobe® PDF datastreams with document and page-level precision.

With InfoPrint ProcessDirector, you can meet production commitments and adapt to unexpected changes without adding staff, shifts or equipment. Instead, move jobs easily across multi-vendor machines, datastreams and sites to improve asset utilization. Boost productivity with the capability to:

- Drive printers and inserters more efficiently

Description

Ricoh announces the release of InfoPrint ProcessDirector V2.4.0 for Windows, AIX and Linux. With this new release, we expand of the capabilities of the InfoPrint ProcessDirector backbone workflow software, offering new functionality that can lower operational costs and improve quality for full document level control of PDF files. With modular features, including vendor-neutral inserter management, InfoPrint ProcessDirector is the premier modular, browser-based, workflow software for job and document management and control.

The base functions of InfoPrint ProcessDirector include:

- Receiving files from IBM z/OS® using Download for z/OS or AFP Download Plus, by copying files to a directory defined as a hot folder, or from a command line print request (such as LPR) to the InfoPrint ProcessDirector LPD receiver
- Managing print queues
- Tracking the production process from receipt of the print file to final delivery
- Using a file viewer to find the pages of AFP and PDF jobs that need to be reprinted
- Interacting with other programs, such as:
 - Third-party applications
 - User-written applications

PDF Mailroom Integrity Feature

The PDF Mailroom Integrity Feature is designed to be an all-inclusive toolset that enables document level control for PDF files – without transforms. This feature enables true Automated Document Factory capabilities for management and control of the print and mail process.

This feature includes several tools:

1. InfoPrint ProcessDirector Plug-in for Adobe Acrobat for creating templates to define document properties and editing rules to be applied to PDF print files
2. Inserter support, which contains all the capabilities to connect InfoPrint ProcessDirector to insertion equipment or camera software and provide file exchange for management of damages, reconciliation and reprints
3. Steps that allow splitting, re-sequencing, and grouping of individual documents within a PDF print file.

The InfoPrint ProcessDirector Plug-in for Adobe Acrobat allows you to visually define and display enhancements using your sample PDF that is representative of PDF files that InfoPrint ProcessDirector processes. Enhancements include creating bar codes and text, and adding images and hidden areas. Your enhancements are not saved in the original PDF; they are saved in a control file that you make available to a server used by InfoPrint ProcessDirector. InfoPrint ProcessDirector uses the control file to apply the same enhancements to production PDF files when processing them for printing.

To make your PDF files ready for mailroom automation, you use the Plug-in to identify triggers in the data that indicate page group boundaries. Then you can mine data from the pages in a page group to be used as document properties. Document properties can be included in a bar code, serve as retrieval cues when trying to locate a specific mailpiece to reprint, or trigger other enhancements to the printed data based on selected conditions. Using the Plug-in, you can hide areas that contain information you no longer wish to print such as OMR marks and add new data such as images and bar codes.

The ability to add barcodes to the printed output is critical to the downstream process automation for tracking and control of every piece and page. The Plug-in supports Data matrix, QR code, 3-of-9, 2-of-5, IMB, and RM4SCC barcodes as well as the older technology of OMR marks. The information in the bar code can change for each page within the page group so it can include information like page number within the mailpiece that the inserter or camera system needs to track each page of the document. Other document properties such as recipient name or account number can be included in the bar code as well. The plug-in can also hide areas on the page – for example to cover up old barcodes that should not be printed.

Inserter Integration

PDF Mailroom Integrity can automate the insertion of printed documents and additional inserts (such as marketing materials) into envelopes. The existing Inserter Features are limited to AFP datastreams. In PDF Mailroom Integrity, you get equivalent functionality for PDF. The inserter function included in this package includes all inserter-related capabilities, such as:

- Preparing print jobs for insertion.
- Writing and sending control files to inserter controllers.
- Receiving results files from inserter controllers and interpreting them to determine the insert status of each document in the job.
- Automatically (or manually, with operator control) reconciling the job, and reprinting any damaged documents.

Supported inserters

File requirements

To enable tracking through the insertion process, input data files must be in Adobe PDF format. The InfoPrint ProcessDirector Plug-in for Adobe Acrobat must be used to identify the page groups in the original input file that correspond to mailpieces.

If you have input files in other data formats you must use a transform product that converts these files to PDF, such as the Advanced Transform Feature.

Insertion Process

InfoPrint ProcessDirector communicates with the inserter controller and reconciles the job after it completes insertion:

1. If the inserter controller uses an inserter control file to control the insertion of documents in a job, InfoPrint ProcessDirector writes the inserter control file for the job and sends it to the inserter controller.
2. The inserter operator manually loads and runs the job on the inserter.
3. InfoPrint ProcessDirector receives the inserter results file (if any) for the job and interprets it to determine which documents need to be reprinted.
4. InfoPrint ProcessDirector reconciles the job
5. InfoPrint ProcessDirector reprints documents in the job:

Splitting, sorting, and grouping documents within PDF jobs

PDF Mailroom Integrity also expands the concept of a print workflow beyond controlling and tracking print jobs to encompass controlling and tracking individual documents in a print job. Without changing the application that creates the print job, you can change the way the individual documents are processed, using business rules to indicate what processing to do. The documents in the print job can be split into subset print jobs, sorted based on document-specific information like address data, or grouped into subset print jobs based on data in the document.

To process individual documents, you can add steps to your workflow based on these step templates:

- GroupDocuments lets you classify all the documents into groups based on up to six document properties. For example, if you had a file of 5000 insurance policy addenda documents, you could group all of them into all the combinations of policy type (auto or home) and state.
- SortDocuments lets you sort documents by up to six document properties. For example, you could alphabetize the policy addenda within each group so you would have all the auto policies in states A-Z followed by all the home policies in states A-Z.
- SplitDocuments lets you divide a large job into several smaller jobs based on the number of documents or the number of sheets in the smaller job.

After you define steps to manipulate the documents into the new grouping and order that you want, you include a step in the workflow that builds a new PDF file with the individual documents organized according to that ordering.

Coexistence of the existing Inserter Feature or Manufacturing Optimization feature and PDF Mailroom Integrity

When you add PDF Mailroom Integrity to an InfoPrint ProcessDirector installation that has the Inserter Feature or the Manufacturing Optimization feature, you can run either AFP or PDF document-level workflows.

If you have PDF Mailroom Integrity and want to add equivalent capabilities to an indexed AFP file, you'll need to purchase the Inserter feature and Manufacturing Optimization feature to enable equivalent functionality on both PDF and AFP.

Reports updates

The Reports feature is separately priced and not part of the PDF Mailroom Integrity Feature. When both Reports and the PDF Mailroom Integrity features are installed on the same system, the Reports feature provides document-level reports such as the Document Reprint report. The Document Reprint report shows files which had been produced and reprinted using the PDF Mailroom Integrity Feature.

***New* Email Output Capabilities**

With new function in the base InfoPrint ProcessDirector server, you can use the SendEmail step template to email any print job, a page range from a PDF or AFP print job, or any other file to one or more email addresses as part of the job's workflow.

If you configure the system settings so the primary server can connect with an SMTP server, you can add the SendEmail step to a job type and configure it to send email with one or more attachments. When the job reaches that step, the step retrieves the files requested, attaches them to an email, and sends the email

to the specified addresses. If you set the Attach ZIP file property to Yes, the step packages all of the attachments in a single ZIP file and attaches it to the email.

You can use this function in various situations:

- If the workflow uses an external program to edit/change jobs, you can send pages from the resulting job to your customer for approval.
- If your customer wants to archive jobs in their own system, you can send jobs to them after they have printed.
- If you have Service Level Agreements (SLAs) with your customers, you can send notifications to them (including sample pages from jobs) when key steps complete successfully.
