Images and text can be quickly transformed and displayed on the screen with the same fidelity as if they were printed. When they view documents presented on the Web using the Ricoh Web Enablement Solutions Suite's programs, your customers can use search and navigation features to quickly retrieve information and easily maneuver within multi-page documents. Printing to any local printer is easy using the print function within Adobe Acrobat Reader.

The Web Enablement Solutions Suite's Ricoh AFP2PDF transform allows you to customize AFP document transformation for improved processing time and viewing. Configuration files can be created to substitute pre-generated graphics and images, such as logos, that regularly appear in your documents. They can also be used to add images to emulate preprinted forms. Use the configuration file to substitute AFP shaded areas with color backgrounds to improve the overall look of the viewed document.

Boost security by defining an owner password that has a default set of permissions for end-user actions with the PDF file. The owner password is designed to control whether or not the end user can modify the document's contents, copy text or graphics from the document, add or modify text annotations or print the document. You can also specify an end-user password, which must be entered before the document can be opened. The Ricoh AFP2PDF transform supports either 40-bit or 128-bit encryption. A user supplied digital signature can be applied to provide another layer of security. The standard transform ships with 40-bit encryption. If you need the 128-bit encryption, contact your Ricoh production specialist for more details.

The Web Enablement Solutions Suite's Ricoh Line2PDF transform allows you take simple line data and convert it so it can be viewed with Adobe Acrobat. Your text is quickly transformed and displayed on the

Description

The Ricoh AFP2PDF Transform converts Advanced Function Presentation (AFP) documents into Adobe Acrobat Portable Document Format (PDF) files. You interact with Ricoh AFP2PDF through a command line or JAVA API interface.

The Ricoh AFP2PDF Transform includes these components:

AFP2PDF

The AFP2PDF transform converts AFP into PDF files.

Split_AFP2PDF

The Split_AFP2PDF transform allows you to split a large AFP print run into individual PDF statements, based on up to three Tagged Logical Element (TLE) values.

The Ricoh Line2PDF Transform converts simple line data into Adobe Acrobat Potable Document Format (PDF) files. It handles both ASCII and EBCDIC and ANSI and machine carriage control. You interact with Line2PDF through a command line or JAVA API interface.

Limitations

The current limitations with the Ricoh AFP2PDF Transform include:

- AFP input files and PDF output files larger than 2 GB are not supported.
- The following set of bar codes are generated in the output PDF when using the Bar Code Object Content Architecture (BCOCA) in AFP data. Any other bar codes are ignored during conversion.
 - Code 39 (3-of-9 Code), AIM USS-39
 - Interleaved 2-of-5, AIM USS-I 2/5
 - POSTNET
 - Code 128, AIM USS)128
 - Japan Postal Bar Code
 - Data Matrix
 - USPS Four-State (IMB)
 - PDF417
 - QR Code
 - Codabar
- When AFP data formatted for N-up partitioning is encountered, the multiple partitions that make up the physical AFP page are converted to separate pages in the PDF file.
- Only limited support is available for object containers with TIFF and JFIF image formats.
- CMR information contained in AFP resources is ignored.
- Unicode Complex Text, such as bidirectional layout processing and glyph processing is not supported.
- Linked fonts for TrueType objects and TrueType font collections are not supported.

The current limitations with the Ricoh Line2PDF Transform include:

- Input text data stream must be mappable to code page 1252. No Double Byte Character Set (DBCS) support.
- TRC characters are not supported.
- Input files larger than 2GB are not supported.

Performance considerations

Transform execution speed varies with the data stream type, job length, output resolutions, and the density and complexity of the average page. Careful evaluation, including benchmarking key jobs, might be required to determine feasibility with a particular Ricoh Web Enablement Solutions Suite's transform configuration. In particular, AFP data streams vary greatly in complexity and it should be expected that transform speeds for similar but different jobs may be significantly different, even on the same hardware configuration.

The customer is responsible for installing and using the Ricoh Web Enablement Solutions Suite's transforms according to documented procedures and for using them in accordance with the Ricoh Production Print Solutions International Product License Agreement (IPLA), which can be found at this Web link:
