# TotalFlow DocEnhancer

## **Overview**

TotalFlow DocEnhancer, a plug-in to Adobe Acrobat Professional, allows you to visually define and display enhancements on fully composed PDF files. Enhancements include creating bar codes and text and adding images and hidden areas.

Total Flow DocEnhancer is used to make PDF files ready for mailroom automation by identifying triggers in the data to indicate page group boundaries. Then you can mine data from the pages in a page group to be used as document properties. Document properties can be included in a bar code, serve as retrieval cues when trying to locate a specific mailpiece to reprint, or be used to conditionally apply other enhancements to the printed data. Using TotalFlow DocEnhancer, you can hide areas that contain information you no longer wish to print, such as OMR marks, and add new data, such as text, images and bar codes.

The ability to add barcodes to the printed output is critical to the downstream process automation for tracking and control of every piece and page. TotalFlow DocEnhancer supports Data matrix, QR code, 3-of-9, 2-of-5, IMB, and RM4SCC barcodes, as well as the older technology of OMR marks. The information in the bar code can change for each page within the page group, so it can include information like page number within the mailpiece that the inserter or camera system needs to track for each page of the document. Other document properties, such as recipient name or account number, can be included in the bar code as well. TotalFlow DocEnhancer can also hide areas on the page – for example you can cover up old barcodes that should not be printed.



# Description

### **TotalFlow DocEnhancer**

- TotalFlow DocEnhancer provides the capability to define document properties and editing rules to be applied to PDF print files
- TotalFlow DocEnhancer allows you to visually define and display enhancements including creating bar codes and text and adding images and hidden areas.

The steps you would take when utilizing DocEnhancer are as follows:

### 1. Define "Page Groups".

A Page Group is the set of indivisible pages that make up a single document within the larger PDF file. DocEnhancer requires a Page Group to be defined in order to apply editing or interpret information within the file. You can choose to treat the entire file as one Page Group, define a fixed number of pages for each Page Group, or define a trigger that appears on the first page of each page group in a defined area on the page (allowing for variable length page groups). An example of a trigger might be the text "Page 1" in the lower right corner or "Invoice" as a title. After setting up the trigger search criteria or fixed length definition, the tool will search every page and build a table with information about the start of every new document.

## 2. Define Document Properties

A Document Property is data about key content within the PDF file and linked to the Page Group where it resides. This is sometimes referred to as "metadata". Using the tool, you can visually identify content that appears within each document. An example might be taking a PDF file with multiple letters in it and identifying the name and address so that you have a simple extraction of the mailing list. This information is written into a side table shown within the Plug-in program. It can be exported into a tab delimited file if so desired. No information about these document properties are saved or marked within the PDF file itself.

### 3. Edit the PDF

The next step in the process is to visually make changes to the PDF in preparation for printing. As you start using the tool to markup and edit the file, you only have to work on the first page group in the file. Any edits or changes you make will be duplicated to the following page groups. You can

- 1. Define any barcodes you want to add to the pages. You can build the barcode with a variety of information, including statistics (what page is this) and information you had defined as document properties (add the recipient name into the barcode)
- 2. Hide areas "Digital white-out" that masks areas on the page that you want to cover up. The information remains buried within the PDF file but will not show during printing.
- 3. Insert images
- 4. Insert text

You can define conditions on how the edits are made. If you'd prefer the changes only happen on *some* of the documents and not others, you can use document properties to set up rules. For example, if you want to insert a picture of a cow for all the people in Wisconsin and a surfboard for those in California, you can identify the state in the address block and then define which state gets which image.


The tool also gives you the option to make the change on every page in the document (like putting a page number barcode on every page may be required), or just on the first page, or last page, or same page in each document.

#### 4. Preview

After you've made your edits, you can Preview the first few pages of the PDF to make sure your edits are appearing in the intended areas. This produces a fully formatted PDF. If the Preview is not to your liking, you can close the preview and return to the original file to adjust the size and placement of your marks.

#### 5. Generate

If you're satisfied with the Preview, you can now generate your final production PDF. Generate will apply your markups to the entire file and produce a fully composed PDF with your desired enhancements. This is the final step in the process. The final PDF can be printed or distributed as needed.
