What's new in Release 1.4.3?

This new update is included in PCL2PDF Version 1.4.3:

- A new installer lets you install PCL2PDF. The installer guides you through setup and simplifies the installation process.
- A trial option is now available. This lets you evaluate the product before purchasing a license.
- Updated zlib to version 1.3.2 to address security vulnerabilities and improve performance.

PCL2PDF - Limitations for Release 1.4.3

This document contains a short description regarding the limitations for PCL2PDF, Version 1.4.3.

The current limitations with the PCL2PDF transform include:

- Revision number for encryption method is V2, from PDF reference documentation.
- Artifex GhostPCL 10.06.0. uses a mechanism of Autofilter that might encode images by using a lossy algorithm. This can result into lower quality images for the benefit of lower PDF output size in some cases.
