Release Notes for PS2PDF, Version 1.4.3

What's new in Release 1.4.3?

These new updates are included in PS2PDF, Version 1.4.3:

- A new installer lets you install PS2PDF. The installer guides you through setup and simplifies the installation process.
- A trial option is now available. This lets you evaluate the product before purchasing a license.
- Updated zlib to version 1.3.2 to address security vulnerabilities and improve performance.

PS2PDF - Limitations for Release 1.4.3

This document contains a short description regarding the limitations for PS2PDF, Version 1.4.3.

The current limitations with the PS2PDF transform include:

- Encryption method revision number is V2, from PDF reference documentation.
- Linearization is incompatible with creating a password protected PDF file. Linearization is ignored when used together with encryption.
- Artifex Ghostscript 10.06.0 uses a mechanism of Autofilter that might encode images by using a lossy algorithm. This can result into lower quality images for the benefit of lower PDF output size in some cases.
