Release Notes for PS2PDF, Version 1.4.1

What's new in Release 1.4.1?

These new updates are included in PS2PDF, Version 1.4.1:

- **Updated the version of Artifex Ghostscript to 10.06.0.**
- **TBCP encoded Postscript files are no longer stripped of this encoding protocol and the transform will generate an error.**

PS2PDF - Limitations for Release 1.4.1

This document contains a short description regarding the limitations for PS2PDF, Version 1.4.1.

The current limitations with the PS2PDF transform include:

- Encryption method revision number is V2 from PDF reference documentation.
- Linearization is incompatible with creating a password protected PDF file. Linearization is ignored when used together with encryption.
- Artifex Ghostscript 10.06.0 uses a mechanism of Autofilter that might encode images by using a lossy algorithm. This can result into lower quality images for the benefit of lower PDF output size in some cases.
